Analysis of Students:

- What are the gender distributions of your students?
- What are the age distributions of your students?
- What are the ethnicity distributions of your students?
- What are your students' educational levels prior to this course?
- Do students have technical skills that are required by your course?
- What are their general learning abilities?
- Do your students have prior knowledge relevant to the course topic?
- Do your students have related working experiences before they take this course?
- What are your students' attitudes toward this course?
- Why do they take this course? What are their expectations of the course?
- What are your students' tendencies toward collaboration and competition?
- What are your students' feelings toward authority?
- What are the distributions of your students' preferred learning styles?

Analysis of Learning Environment

- What learning platform is used in your course (Blackboard, WebCT, Desire2Learn)?
- What technologies are used for course presentations?
- What technologies are used for evaluations of student performance?
- Are videos used in your course? What is the format of the video? What hardware do students have to have to watch the videos?
- Does your course use synchronous/asynchronous discussions? What software are used in the discussions?
- What hardware/software are commonly available for students in your class?

What are other recourses that are available to your students?

What is the size of your class? How many students are enrolled in your course?
