




HORMONAL METHODS: LARC

____ - 3 types:


- Depo-provera ("the shot"), 3 months
- Implanon ("the implant"), 3 years
- Intra-uterine device (IUD), 5-10 years
















THE FUTURE OF CONTRACEPTIVES
